

Westpac Staff Super Ballot – Tony Elected

FSU endorsed candidates for the Westpac Staff Super Plan (WSSP) elections had a strong showing in the recent ballot with Tony Bowden being elected to one of the vacant Director positions.

Tony Bowden, State Manager, PFS, Qld received the highest number of votes, coming first in the ballot. The other FSU endorsed candidate Tony Thompson also performed strongly, coming in third behind incumbent Director, Deborah Thompson.
