**Office attendance arrangements**

I am writing in response to your letter to the Governor dated 23 March 2026, which requests an immediate suspension of office attendance requirements.

Subject to specific operational needs, the RBA currently supports employees to work from home for up to half of their working time. This flexibility is provided by the RBA to embrace both the benefits of working remotely and the benefits of coming together in person.

Working together in the office remains an important part of the way we work. Collaboration, connection and shared learning support the open and dynamic culture we are building and enables us to deliver effectively on the RBA's responsibilities to the Australian public.

At this time, we have no plans to change our working from home or office attendance arrangements.

We acknowledge the concerns raised by the FSU regarding economic uncertainty. The RBA remains attentive to developments in the broader environment.
